APPLICATIONS AND ABSTRACTS

To participate in the conference application and abstracts should be sent to the address of the Organizing Committee You can send an e-mail address: biospace2013@mail.ru.

The application must include: name, surname, academic degree participant, the name of the organization, contact address, telephone numbers, e-mail, the name of the report and its form (oral/poster), the form of participation in the congress (full-time/part-time), additional comments (if it's necessary).

Abstracts should be submitted to Organizing Committee in Russian (or Ukrainian) and English. The abstract (in a bilingual format) must not exceed two A4 (WinWord, pt 10, Arial), including figures, tables and references.

Each file sent by e-mail, should include:

- title of the abstract, the initials and names, names of institutions;
- the abstract text;
- scientific topics;
- information about the payment of publishing costs.

Name of the file given by the first author's surname and serial number of abstracts (if the author represents more than one work), for example: Petrov1.doc; Petrov2.doc.

Please, ask Organizing Committee on e-mail about the Conference participation and registration fee payment.

Deadline for applications and abstracts by e-mail is **August 1, 2013.**

Simultaneous interpretation is not provided, so the multimedia presentations and poster sessions is recommended to prepare in English.
